Medical Advisory Services

Our global Operations Centers in six countries are standing by 24/7 to provide our members with immediate access to our paramedics, nurses and physicians, including the medical teams at Elite Medical Group, the Johns Hopkins Emergency Medicine Division of Special Operations and Partners Healthcare to provide lifesaving consultative support to our members.

Medical Evacuation

Global Rescue deployable medical teams, over 1,000 contracted aircraft and more than 200 medical centers of excellence worldwide are continuously available to provide care to and evacuate our members via private and commercial aircraft and helicopters to the destination hospital of our members' choosing. All transport costs up to \$500,000 are included in the cost of membership.

Security Extraction

If you are faced with a security emergency, natural disaster, terrorist attack, government ordered evacuation or civil unrest while traveling, our teams of military special operations veterans will get you to safety and bring you home. All transport costs up to \$100,000 are included in the cost of membership.

Critical medical, security and information resources are available at the touch of a button anywhere in the world. Detailed destination reports from our in-house teams of intelligence analysts provide critical insight into the health and security risks in countries you may plan to visit. You can also keep track of the people you care about and they can keep track of you.

Mortal Remains Transport

Should a member suffer a fatal event, we will bring the remains to the home country morgue of your choosing. All transport costs up to \$15,000 are included in the cost of membership.

- Medical training programs in tactical and operational medicine.
